2012 HALL OF FAME INDUCTEE

Jamarr Billman District 11 Wrestler



Jamarr Billman is a 1997 graduate of Easton High School and a 2001 graduate of Lock Haven University with a B.S. degree in education. At Easton High School, he was a three-time District 11 champion, two-time Northeast Regional champion, four-time PIAA state placewinner including two state titles in 1996 and 1997. In 1996, Jamarr was Junior National freestyle champion. He amassed a 141-17 record while competing while Coach Steve Powell's Red Rover team. Billman began his career at Penn State where he was third in the Big Ten conference and was named Big Ten Freshman of the Year. His 56-6 record for the Nittany Lions included placing fifth at 142 pounds in the 1998 NCAA Championships as a freshman. He entered his sophomore year as the top-ranked wrestler in the country at 149 pounds and proceeded to amass a 21-0 record before being ruled academically ineligible for the second semester. Billman transferred to Lock Haven University, where in two seasons he compiled a 61-7 record and earned All-America honors twice by finishing fifth at 149-pounds at the NCAA championships in 2001 and 2002. Billman also won Eastern Wrestling League and Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference championships at Lock Haven in 2001 and 2002. As a senior, he posted a 36-4 record and led LHU with eight pins, and he went 25-3 and topped the squad with eight pins as a junior. His overall collegiate record was an impressive 117-13. In 2009, Jamarr was elected to the District 11 Wrestling Hall of Fame.
