A Summer Recreation Program, sponsored and funded by the Joint Recreation Board, will be held in the summer of 2019. The municipalities that comprise the Joint Recreation Board are Bradford Woods, Franklin Park, Marshall Township and the Town of McCandless. Applications are being accepted from qualified applicants.

JOB DESCRIPTIONS

Center Director

Will be directly responsible for his/her assigned center. He/she will report to the Chairman of the Joint Recreation Board and to the Coordinator. He/she will be responsible for the buildings, grounds, all equipment and personnel assigned to the center. He/she will carry out all other duties as assigned.

Qualifications – He/she should be a certified teacher with at least five (5) years teaching experience. He/she should currently be teaching in the North Allegheny School District. He/she must be experienced in this type of recreation program. The salary will be \$1,660 for the 20-day program. A person with a high degree of skill may also be considered for this position.

Arts & Crafts Instructors

Will work as assigned by the Joint Recreation Board. He/she will work and report directly to the Center Director where he/she is assigned.

Qualifications – A certified teacher with teaching experience is preferred for this position.
A person with a high degree of skill may also be considered. The salary will be \$1,165 for the 20-day program.

Professional Aide

Will work as assigned by the Joint Recreation Board. He/she will work and report directly to the Center Director where he/she is assigned.

Qualifications – Anyone qualifying for either a center director or assistant director will also qualify, at the discretion of the Joint Recreation Board, as a professional aide. The Joint Recreation Board may consider a person with prior experience as meeting the qualifications for professional aide. The salary will be \$1,120 for the 20-day program.

General Aide

Will assist in any of the duties assigned. College students majoring in education are preferred. Arts and crafts, physical education, or recreation background will be given priority. The Joint Recreation Board may consider a person with prior experience as meeting the qualifications for General Aide. The salary will be \$845 for the 20-day program.

Preference

Preference will be given to the employees of the North Allegheny School District and/or residents of the district. Previous experience in the program will also be considered.

Salaries

Salaries will be paid in one lump sum at the conclusion of the program, less normal deductions as required by law.

Hours

Arrival time no later than 8:30 a.m. Dismissal will be at 12:30 p.m., unless preparations or short meetings are necessary. Students' hours are from 8:45 a.m. to 12:00 noon.

Monday, June 10, 2019, to Friday, July 3, 2019. The dates are subject to change due to possible changes in the school calendar. There will not be a program on July 4th in observance of Independence Day.
